## DISCLOSURE OF MATERIAL IMPACT OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Pursuant to the SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD1/CIR/P/2020/84 dated 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2020, disclosure of material impact of COVID-19 pandemic is as follows:

1. Impact of COVID-19 pandemic on the business:

The outbreak of COVID-19 has resulted in the economic slowdown worldwide. The Company's manufacturing activities were shut from 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2020 to 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 due to the lockdown announced in the country. The Company partially recommenced its manufacturing activities from 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 adhering to Notification No. DMU/2020/CR.92/DisM-1 dated 17/04/2020 issued by the Government of Maharashtra with respect to the safety measures to be taken due to COVID-19 pandemic. However, it is difficult to quantify the overall impact of the outbreak presently.

2. Ability to maintain operations including the factories / units / office spaces functioning and closed down. Schedule, if any, for restarting the operations:

The Company partially recommenced its manufacturing activities from 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 adhering to Notification No. DMU/2020/CR.92/DisM-1 dated 17/04/2020 issued by the Government of Maharashtra with respect to the safety measures to be taken due to COVID-19 pandemic.

3. Steps taken to ensure smooth functioning of operations:

The Company is taking all the precautions as per the advisory / notifications issued by the Central Government and Government of Maharashtra. The precautionary measures taken by the Company include:

- Thermal Screening of all the employees and the visitors at the entry point of the Company
- Sanitizing the premises on regular basis
- Compulsion on wearing of masks by anyone and everyone entering the Company premises and regularly washing of hands
- Compulsion on installing Aarogya Setu App by all the employees
- Maintaining social distancing at the workplace of all the employees



4. Estimation of future impact of COVID-19 on the operations:

COVID-19 will certainly have a negative impact on the business operations of the Company for the financial year 2020-21. However, presently it is difficult to quantify its impact for the
